She has authored numerous publications in the field of Transfusion Medicine including a chapter of red blood cell and platelet immunizations in pregnancy, used at the Medical School in Sweden. Dr. Wikman is coauthor of the National Clinical Guidelines on immunization in pregnancy and is the Scientific Advisor in Transfusion Medicine for the National Board of Health and Welfare. She is a member of the ISBT Working Party in Platelet Immunology and National Coordinator of Patient Blood Management in Sweden.
